

STAVROPOL STATE AGRARIAN UNIVERSITY

Stavropol State Agrarian University is a leading Russian center of higher education, culture and science, which is carrying out educational, scientific research, consulting and methodical activity. It is a state institution of higher education under federal jurisdiction, which is located in the North Caucasus Federal District, Stavropol. The University was established in 1930.

Nowadays there are 9 faculties, 41 academic departments, 83 innovative laboratories and centers, Scientific library, institute of additional professional education (IAPE), 6 dormitories, 2 sports complexes, horse-riding school, 3 plant houses, 3 vivaria.

The university has educational and experimental farm with total area of 9609.6 hectares, which is equipped with modern agricultural machinery.

About 15 500 enrolled students are currently taught in 126 higher education programs (undergraduate, graduate, specialties, post-graduate), including 240 international students (from 37 countries). 91.3% of staff members have an academic degree, including 21.6% doctors of sciences. The average age of employees is 39 years.

Tuition Fee: 90 000 – 105 000 rubles (intramural form of study);

30 000 – 45 000 rubles (extramural form of study)

Housing Fee: 1 250 - 2 500 rubles per month.

Pre-study courses (Russian language, mathematics, informatics, biology) are available for foreign applicants. The tuition fee - 85 000 rubles, duration 8 months.

Since 2008 the Stavropol State Agrarian University has been a Member of the Magna Charta of universities, and in 2009 it became a member of the European University Association of Natural Sciences.

SSAU is an active participant of international educational, scientific and cultural programs such as ERASMUS+, has more than 140 partners in 66

countries – Germany, Netherlands, Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Hungary, Switzerland, Lithuania and others.

In 2017 according to one of the largest international news agencies MIA "Russia Today" Stavropol SAU is in the ranking of the most in-demand Russian higher educational institutions, it is steadily taking the 1st place in the category "Agricultural universities." Moreover on the results of the annual ranking of universities of Russian and International rating agency RAEX ("Expert RA") Stavropol State Agrarian University is the one and only agricultural university in Russia and the only institution of higher education in the North Caucasus Federal District, which is in the top 100 in the prestigious national ranking.

Stavropol State Agrarian University is a holder of prestigious awards in the field of quality:

Three times winner of the European competition of EFQM Excellence Award (2016, 2013, 2010).

Three times laureate of the RF Government Prize in the field of quality (2017, 2011, 2005).

Stavropol State Agrarian University has become the center of innovative and technological development of the Stavropol territory as the winner of National project "Universities as an area for the creation of innovations". SSAU is the only agricultural university in Russian Federation, which has such status.
